So, what's the difference between a PAC Member and a PAC Executive?

- <u>PAC Executives</u> are those parents who have chosen to hold an official position within the PAC. These executive positions are volunteer positions with no compensation provided by the school.
- PAC Members can help the PAC throughout the year in fundraising or other initiatives as requested by the PAC Executives, or simply just to attend the PAC meetings to find out what's happening.

We encourage all the Parent/Guardian(s) who are PAC members to attend the PAC meetings; you will not be assigned to any tasks without your willing to do so. It's a great hour meeting once a month where the atmosphere is very light, we have some good laughs and you get to know the Principal and your PAC Executive team. The key to attending is that you as a parent/guardian will be kept informed of what's happening in the school that your child is attending and gives our children a sense that their parents care about their education. In the PAC meeting we also take votes in decisions where PAC member's votes are critical especially when it comes to allocating on how to spend the funds provided by the government and via our fundraising. 


FUNDRAISERS
